LEGISLATIVE REPRESENTATION

The ISA has a strong legislative voice with registered lobbyists at the State Capitol and an active Legislative Committee that keeps the members updated on issues related to the seed industry. ISA members are also provided with the opportunity to meet and discuss issues with legislators at meetings and through various other forums.

COOPERATION WITH ISU & IOWA DEPARTMENT OF AGRICULTURE

The ISU Seed Science Center is a portal for the Iowa seed industry and a source point for education and information. This center has a permanent seat on the ISA Board of Directors. ISA also works closely with the Iowa Department of Agriculture and Land Stewardship on regulations affecting the seed industry.

SCHOLARSHIPS FOR ISU UNDERGRAD & GRADUATE STUDENTS

The industry has raised over \$1 Million towards this important program. ISA annually awards over ten scholarships to ISU undergraduate students. Tuition for graduate students in seed sciences is also awarded.

ANNUAL CONVENTION

ISA has partnered with the Agribusiness Showcase & Conference to provide training and education to members.

ANNUAL GOLF TOURNAMENT

All proceeds from the Golf Tournament go to the ISU Seed Scholarship programs. The tournament is a fun way for members to meet with those they already know and an opportunity to make new contacts as well.
